**SUBJECT : RELOCATION OF RORO FROM SAPANGAR BAY CONTAINER
PORT TO KOTA KINABALU PORT**

1. DIRECTIVE

This circular is issued to officially notify all stakeholders of the relocation of RORO from Sapangar Bay Container Port (SBCP) to Kota Kinabalu Port operated by Sabah Ports Sdn. Bhd. (SPSB). In parallel, Sabah Ports Authority (SPA) has granted SPSB for the **temporary use** of land measuring approximately 6.28 acres located at Jalan Tanjung Lipat, Kota Kinabalu ("the Said Land") as the RORO Holding Location. This measure is implemented as a temporary operational solution to ease the congestion at Sapangar Bay Container Port (SBCP).

The use of the Said Land shall comply with the following requirements:

1.1 MANDATORY USAGE

The Said Land is to be used as the **MANDATORY** transit area outside of Kota Kinabalu Port. RORO vehicles are strictly prohibited from parking outside of Kota Kinabalu Port areas or any public areas not approved for such purpose. SPSB shall take counter measure action including penalties and/or suspension of account (where appropriate) for any violation of this instruction.

1.2 TARIFF CHARGES

Applicable port tariff is in accordance with the Sabah Ports Authority (Scale of Dues and Charges) Regulations 1977.

1.3 STORAGE CHARGES

A **free storage period of three (3) days** shall be applicable. Any vehicle exceeding this period will be subject to **storage charges**.

1.4 DURATION OF IMPLEMENTATION

This arrangement shall take effect from **15th May 2026 until further notice**.

2. COMPLIANCE OF IMPLEMENTATION

Port users and port operator are required to strictly comply with all terms and conditions as stipulated herein.

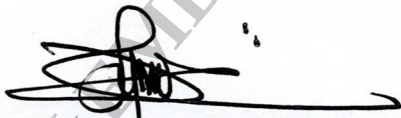
